



**THE 2005 JOHN DAVID ANELLO, SR. &
ALBERT A. SILVERMAN
MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Civic Music Association, in collaboration with the Milwaukee chapter of **UNICO**, an Italian American service organization, announces the John David Anello, Sr. Memorial Scholarship (made possible by a donation from Al Silverman). This scholarship is open to vocalists and players of any instrument whose primary residence is in Wisconsin.

ELIGIBILITY: Scholarship candidates, in addition to the above, must also:

- (1) Have one Italian parent or grandparent, and
- (2) Be a full-time high school or college student between 14-22 years old.

AUDITION: Auditions will be by CD or cassette tape. Please submit a high quality recording to Civic Music Association, *Attention: Anello Scholarship*. The audition recording should contain approximately 15 minutes of music performed by the applicant, including at least two contrasting periods and styles. Minimum level of difficulty: Class A WSMA. Applicants should not speak or verbally identify themselves on the tape. The tape must be labeled with the titles and composers of the works included, soloist's and accompanist's names, and the date(s) of the recording(s).

JUDGES: Professional musicians and teachers will serve as judges.

ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 (non-refundable, payable to Civic Music Association) must be submitted with the application. Admission to topic-related workshops on Saturday, February 5, and admission to the High School Showcase Recital on Sunday, February 6, 2005, is included in this fee. If you have financial concern regarding this fee, please contact CMA.

DEADLINE: The application, CD or tape, and \$15 application fee must be postmarked no later than **December 15, 2004**.

PRIZE: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship or two (2) \$500 scholarships, as determined by the judges, will be awarded to further the student's musical skills.

The name(s) of the prize winner(s) will be announced during the **CMA Music Competition Weekend** on Sunday, February 6th, following a 2:00 p.m. recital at the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music's Helen Bader Recital Hall, 1584 North Prospect Avenue. The scholarship(s) will be presented at the **UNICO Scholarship and Awards Reception** in spring of 2005 at the Italian Community Center in Milwaukee.
