AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED:

High School Showcase

Eligibility: Open to all greater Milwaukee metropolitan area high school sophomores, juniors and seniors.
Prize: \$100 award and recital opportunity to each winner.

Elizabeth W. Boyce Young Artists Scholarships

Eligibility: Open to all greater Milwaukee metropolitan area high school sophomores, juniors and seniors.
Prize: \$2,000 in scholarship awards.

Donald & Idabelle Mohr Memorial Music Scholarship

Eligibility: Open to MPS graduating seniors pursuing further education in a musical field, including music education, music therapy, theory-composition, performance and musicology.
Prize: \$200-\$400 in scholarship awards.

John David Anello Sr. & Albert A. Silverman Memorial Scholarship

(offered by the Milwaukee chapter of UNICO, an Italian American service organization)

Eligibility: Open to full-time high school or college vocalists & instrumentalists between 14-22 years old whose primary residence is in Wisconsin and who have one Italian parent or grandparent.
Prize: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship or two (2) \$500 scholarships will be presented at the UNICO Scholarship Awards Reception in spring of 2005 at the Milwaukee Italian Community Center.

APPLICATION & AUDITION INFORMATION

Judges: Professional musicians and teachers will jury.
Accompanists: Auditionees are expected to perform with a professional accompanist and must provide their own. CMA can provide a list of accompanists, if needed.
Application Fee: \$15 (nonrefundable, payable to Civic Music Association) must be submitted with the application.
Workshop Fee: Free for applicants/\$5 for pre-registered nonapplicants/\$10 for walk-in nonapplicants
How to Apply: Applications can be printed from CMA's website at www.civictimusicmilwaukee.org. Completed applications along with the application fee must be submitted by the deadline below.
Deadline: All applications must be postmarked no later than **December 15, 2004**.

High School Showcase, Mohr & Boyce Scholarships

Live Audition: 4-6 minutes of music (minimum level Class A WSMA); memorization is optional.
Repertoire: Instrumentalists: one work, or one movement of a multi-movement work; Vocalists: one or more songs to fulfill the time requirement.

Anello & Silverman Memorial Scholarship

Recorded Audition: Submit a CD or cassette tape labeled with the titles and composers of the works included, soloist's and accompanist's names, and the date(s) of recording. Applicants should not speak or verbally identify themselves on the tape.
Repertoire: 12-15 minutes of music (minimum level Class A WSMA), including at least two contrasting periods and styles.
